







Q5 - If you spoke to someone in the Graduate School, what was your experience?






Q7 - If you spoke with a faculty member, what was your experience?

Q8 - Since applying to Washington State University, did you learn any new information





attend WSU?




Q10 - Were you offered an assistantship at Washington State University?

Unorganized


There was no guaranteed funding for the masters program and the masters program was not part of the PhD program, unlike the other universities I applied to.



Q15 - Would you have preferred more or less correspondence from WSU?



Q16 - Do you feel that WSU did everything possible to provide you with the information


