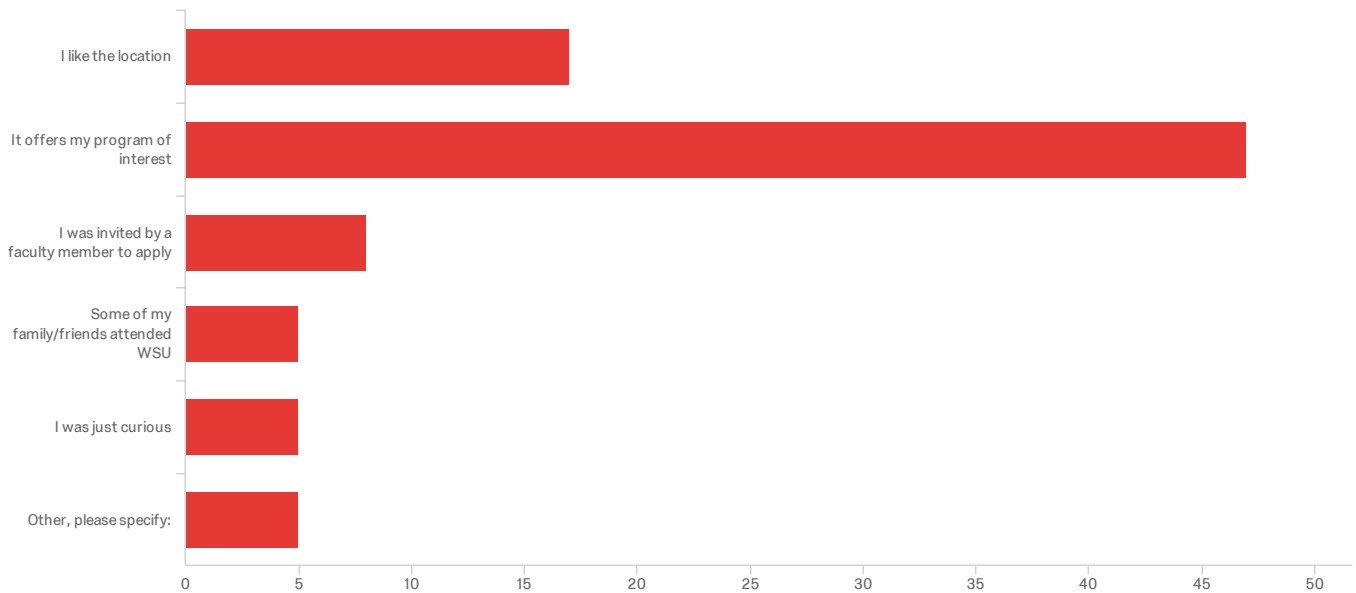

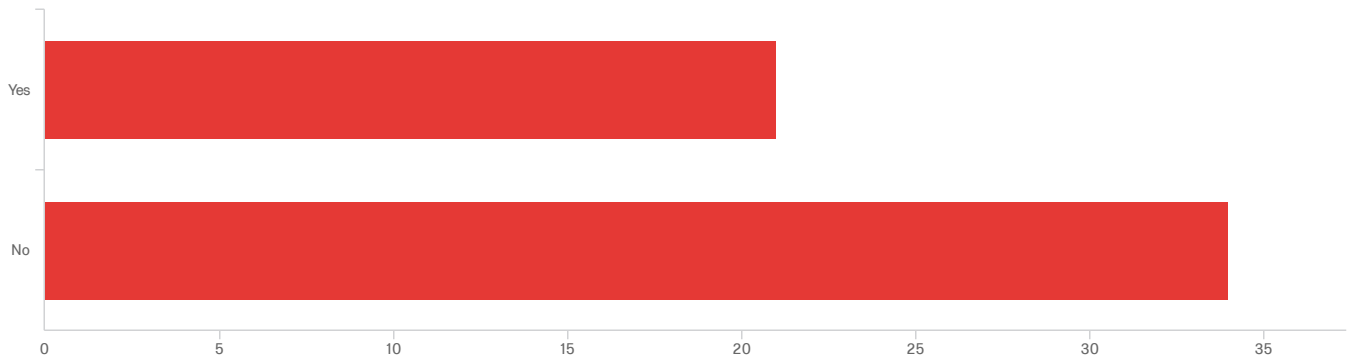

Q2 - Were you invited to WSU for a campus visit?



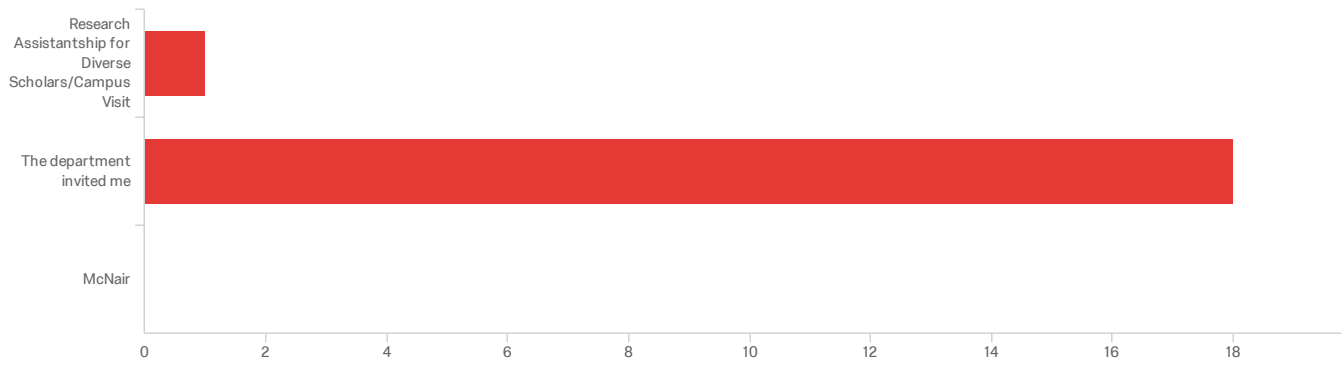

Q3 - If yes, which campus visit did you attend?

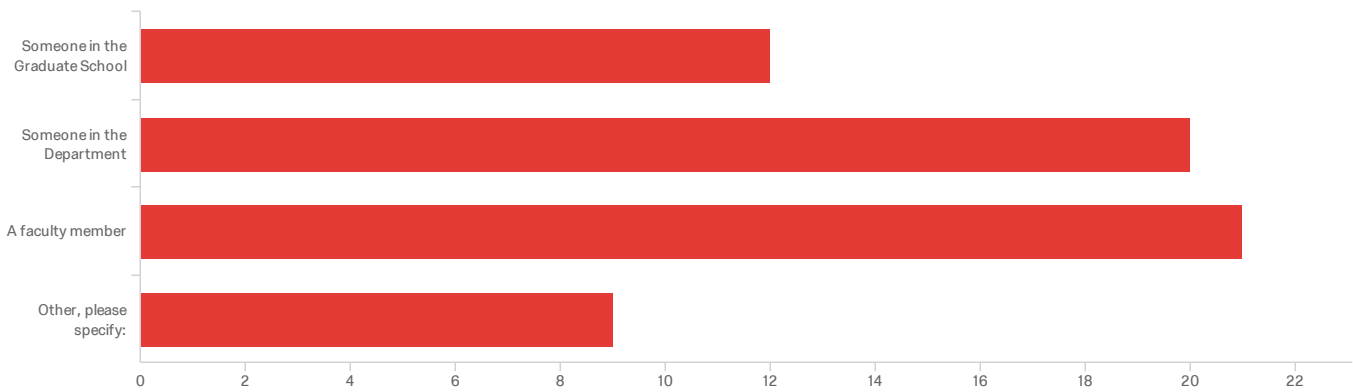

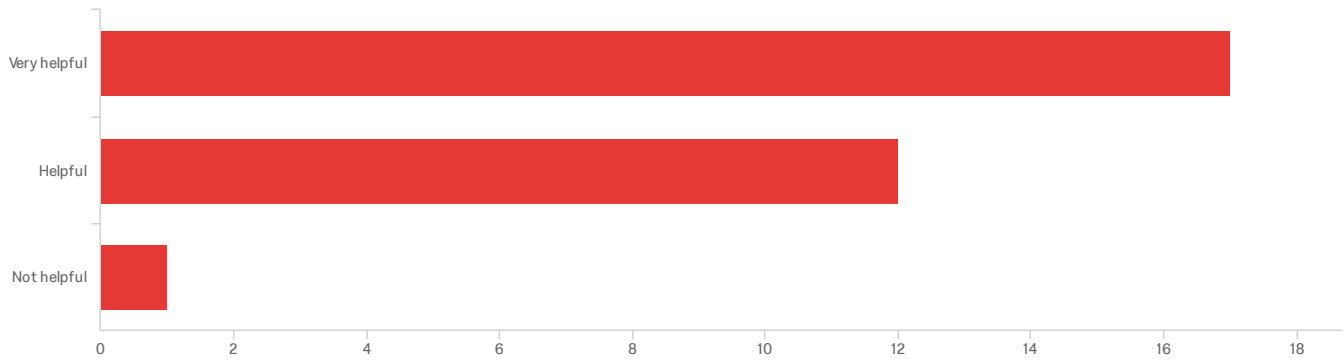

Q5 - If you spoke to someone in the Graduate School, what was your experience?

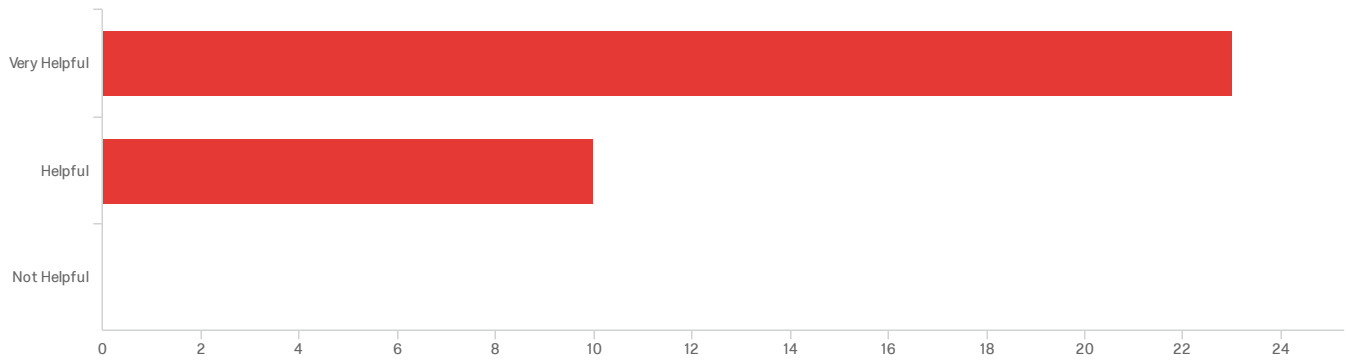

Q6 - If you spoke with someone in a department, what was your experience?

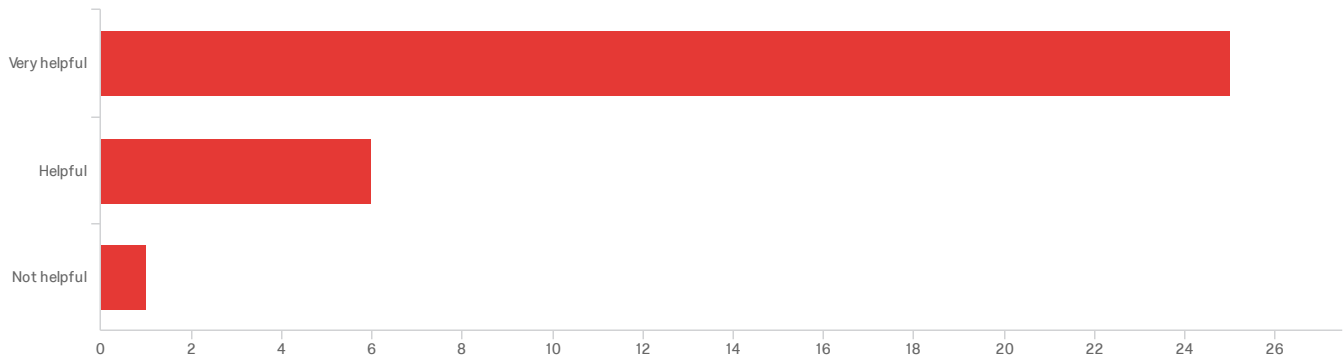

Q7 - If you spoke with a faculty member, what was your experience?

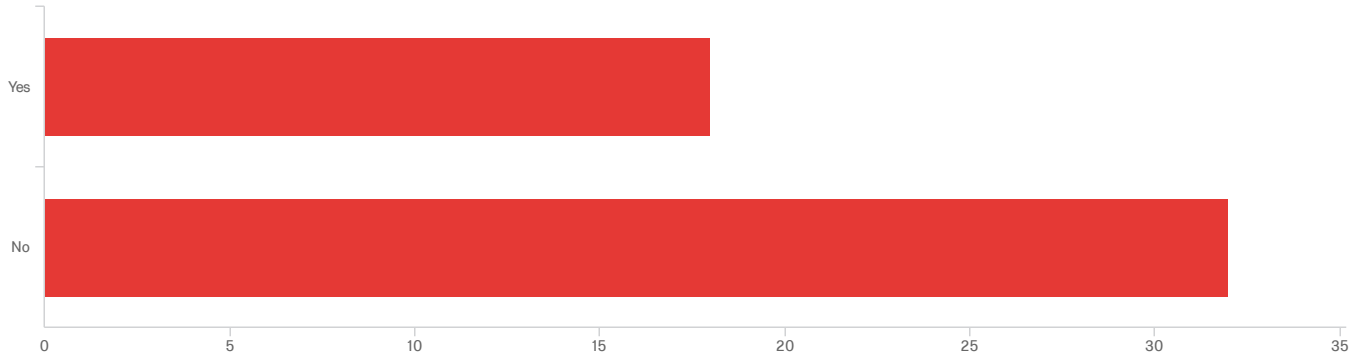

I mainly decided not to attend WSU because of the lack of funding opportunities (i.e. an assistantship of some kind).

The faculty members I wanted to work with were at different WSU locations

It definitely made the decision harder when I visited campus. However, the ultimate decision came down to money. I did receive any assistance from the university.

No scholarship or assistantship offered.also, Admission Dept delayed sending me i20 for trivial reasons

I was offered a graduate teaching position at a competing institution.

I did not receive funding.

I got a better offer at Virginia Tech. I received full tuition waiver and monthly stipend.

Funding did not seem gaurenteed, better research fit elsewhere.

I was accepted to another program (FSU) which also fit my research interests and was much closer. Ultimately, having a terminally ill spouse, a young child, and very little money made it untenable to move thousands of miles to a place I'd never seen. Simply, the matter came down to money and what was best for my family. Everyone from the faculty who spoke to me while I was deciding was helpful and if I had been young and single things might have gone a different way.

Montana State University

The hybrid program involved attending a location in person twice a week, and the average completion time was 5 years.

I was accepted, but the funding offered was better at a different University

Stipend amount, residual tuition fee, campus feel

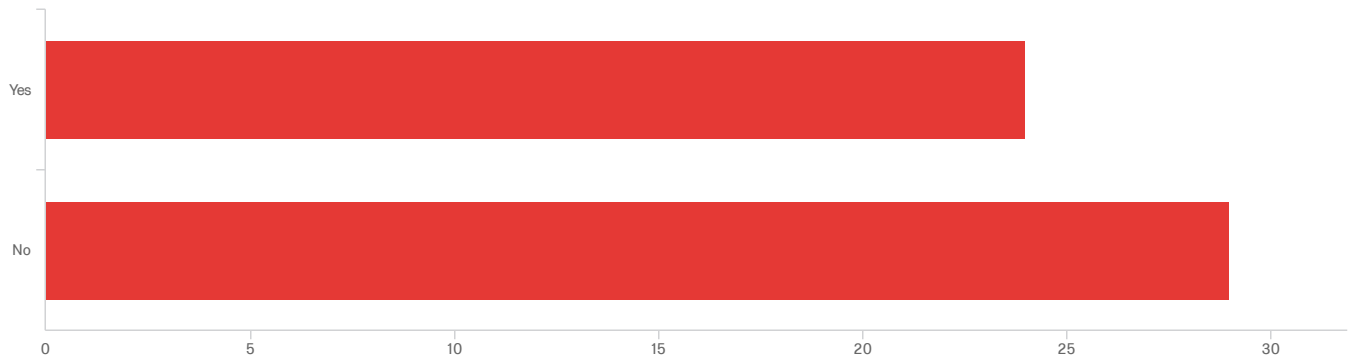

Q10 - Were you offered an assistantship at Washington State University?



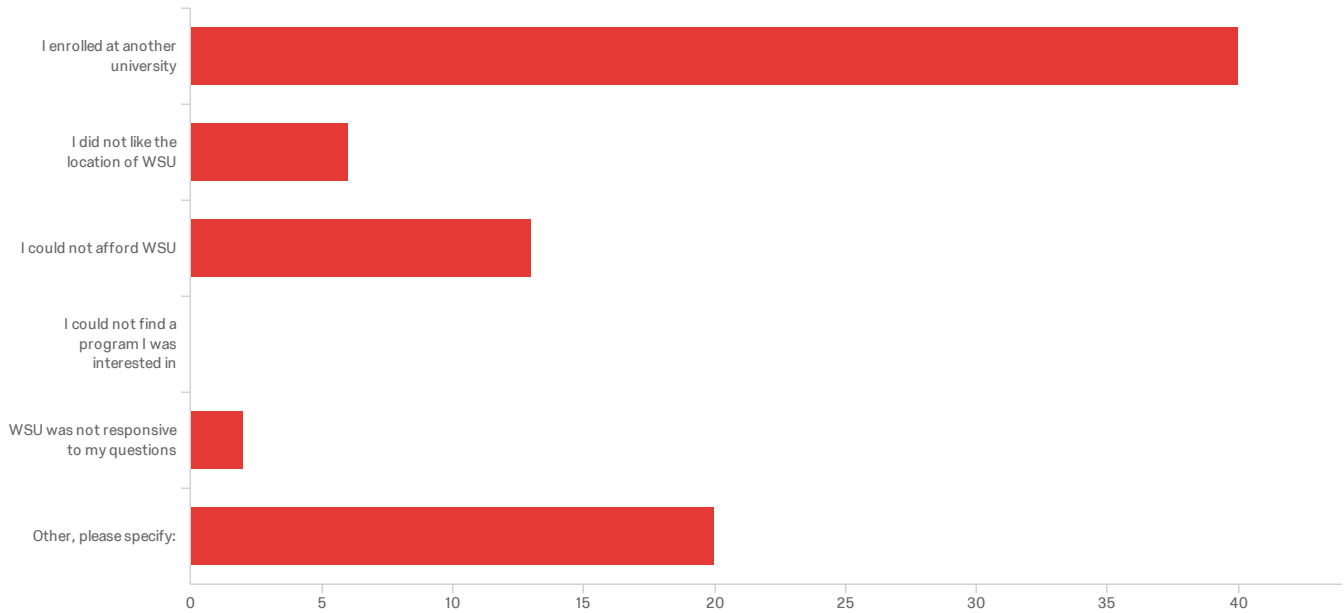

My mother was diagnosed with cancer and I do not feel comfortable leaving her during this time.

The other school offered money and WSU did not.

The stipend was very low

Not seeking a certificate program

I did a lot of thinking after being accepted and decided that I no longer wished to pursue graduate school at this point.

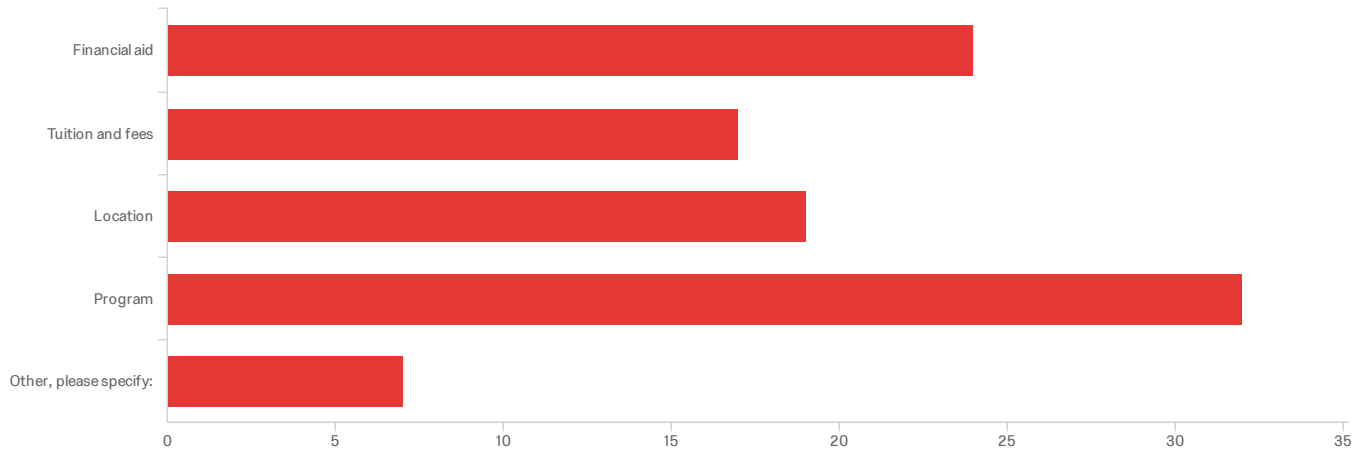
Unorganized

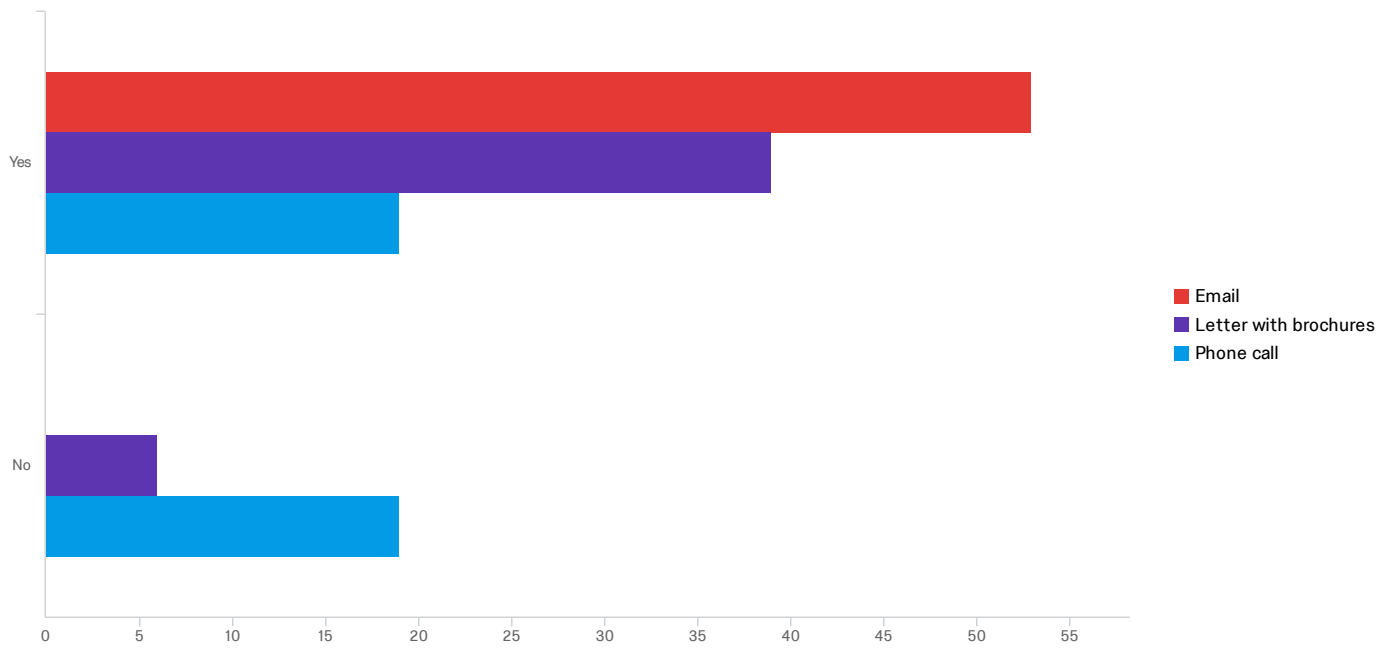

Q14 - After you applied for admission to WSU, what correspondence did you receive?

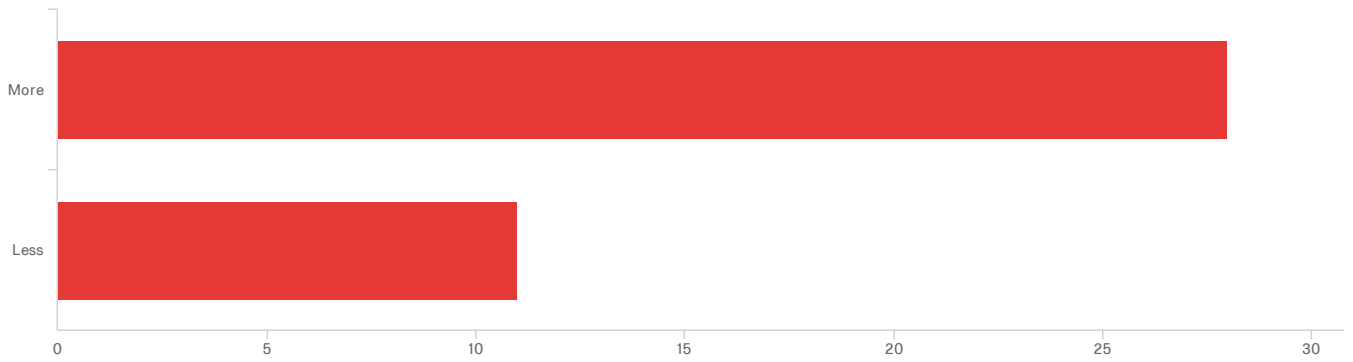

Q15 - Would you have preferred more or less correspondence from WSU?



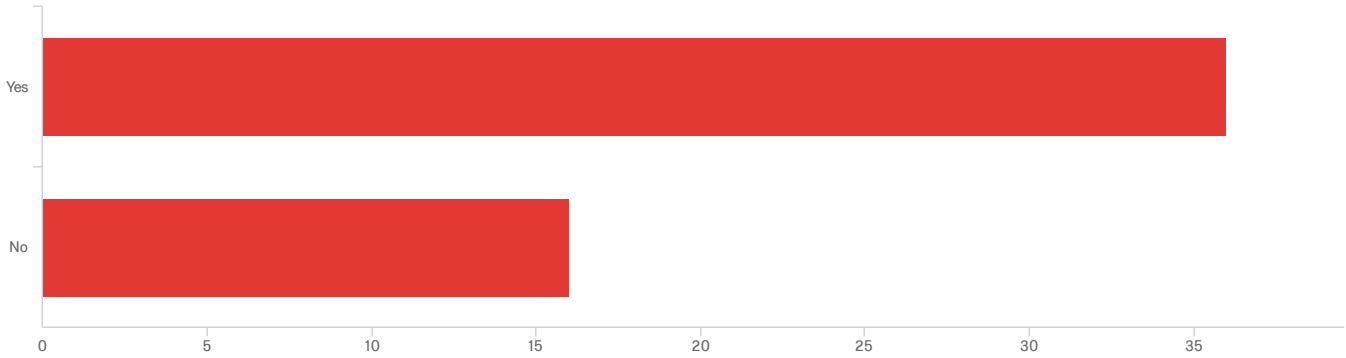

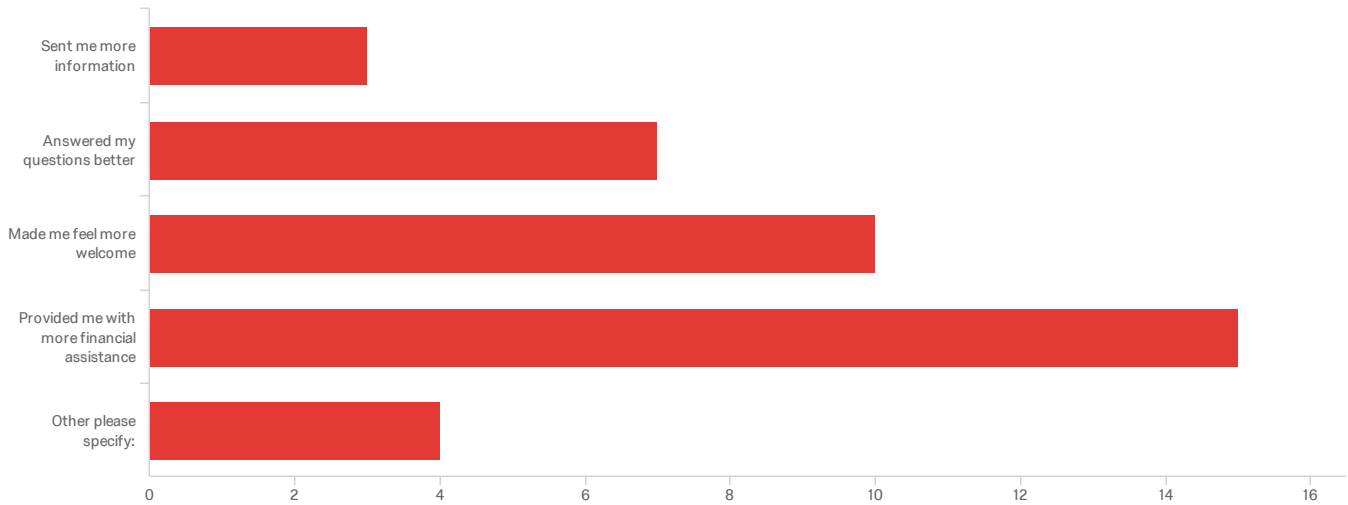
