Examples include: 1) a new faculty member, who was a WSU graduate student, serving on the advisory committee of a former graduate peer; and 2) a faculty member, who is the employer/supervisor of a staff member pursuing a degree, also serving on that staff member's advisory committee. | It is prudent to acknowledge, and when possible avoid, situations that may constitute or may be construed as a conflict of interest when forming a graduate student's advisory committee. Examples of potential perceived or real conflicts of interest include: 1) a new faculty member, who was a WSU graduate student, serving on the advisory committee of a former graduate peer; 2) a faculty member, who is the employer/supervisor of a staff member pursuing a degree, also serving on that staff member's advisory committee; and 3) faculty members whose impartiality may be impacted because of close professional or personal relationships that are separate from their WSU faculty roles. | This paragraph has been in the P&P for many years, to serve as a reminder of the importance of considering possible conflicts of interest when selecting faculty to serve on a student's advisory committee. The intent of this paragraph is to provide guidance, with the philosophy that acknowledging the potential for a COI is the major step in managing the situation if issues do arise. The paragraph was not intended to constitute strictly enforced policies—in particular because the Graduate School cannot consistently identify when conflicts of interest may exist. In the 2020-21 P&P manual, examples 1 and 2 were added, with GSC and Faculty Senate Approval. In this edition, an additional example is included, and the language was revised to clarify guiding intent of the paragraph. |
