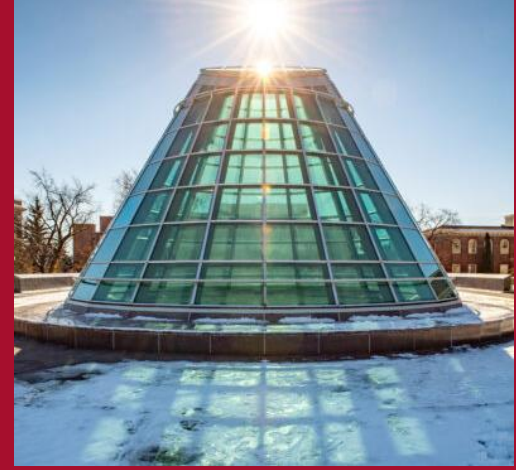

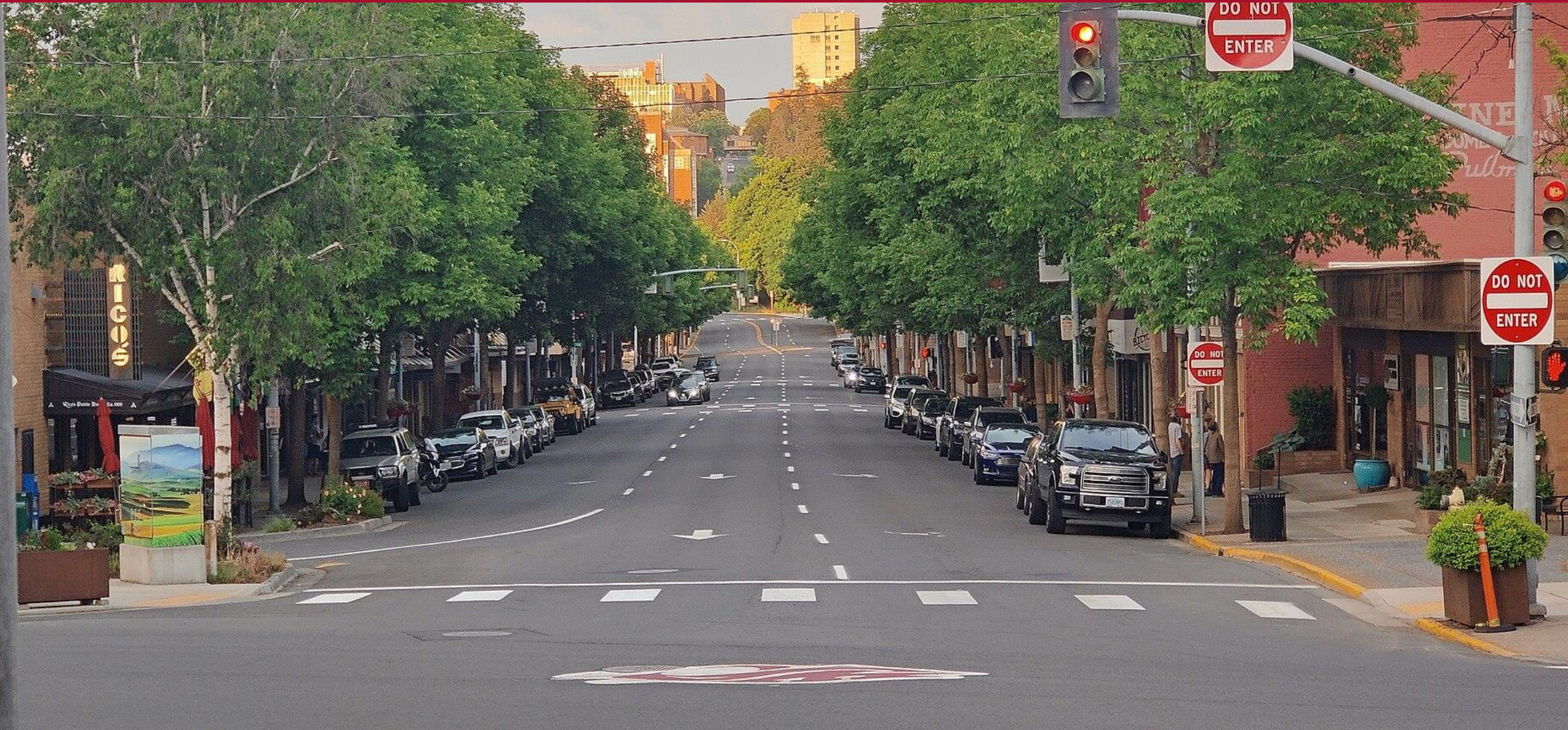

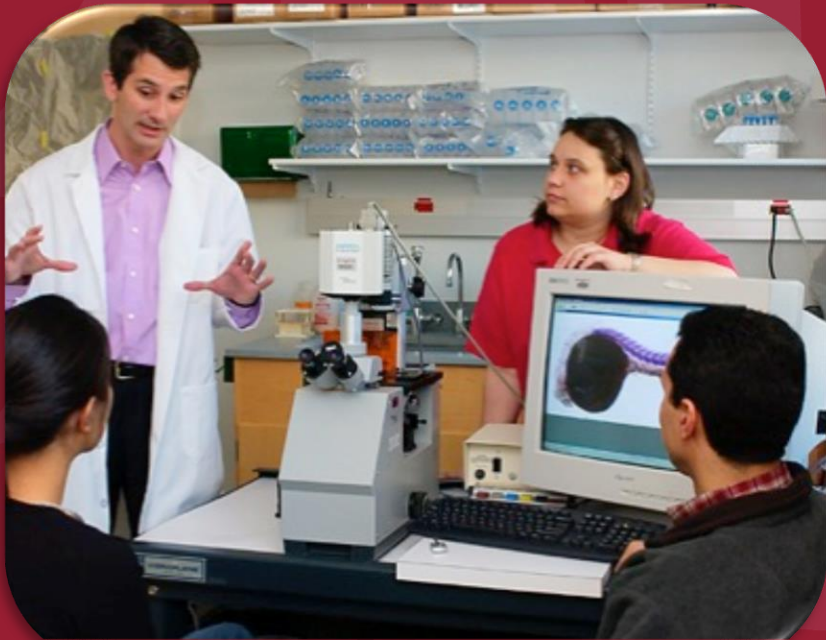


# Graduate Education and Research at WSU

We advocate for WSU's graduate students across the state of Washington, nationally, and globally.

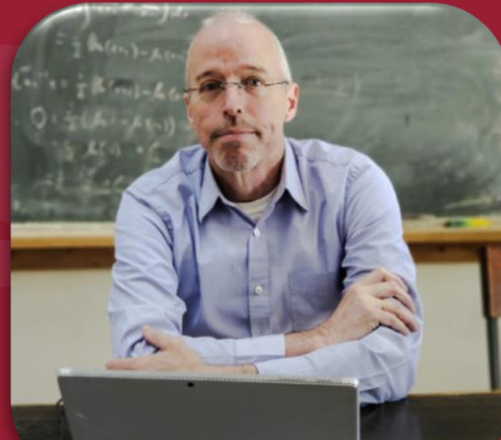

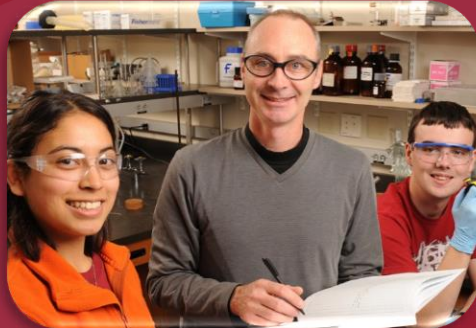

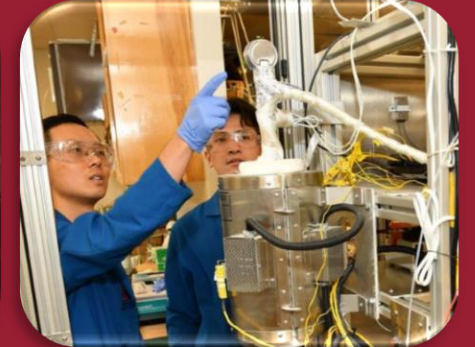
